Kew Dance

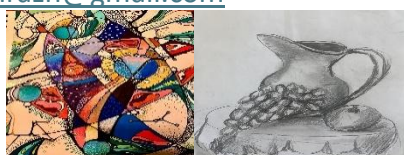
Please see information attached regarding Kew Dance Club which runs on a Wednesday after school.
